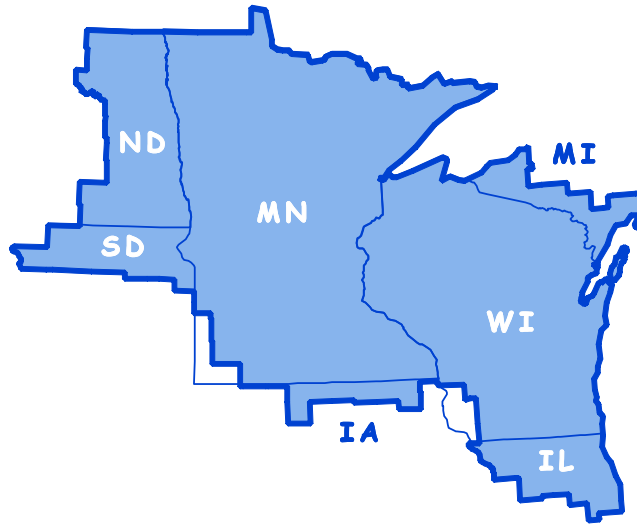

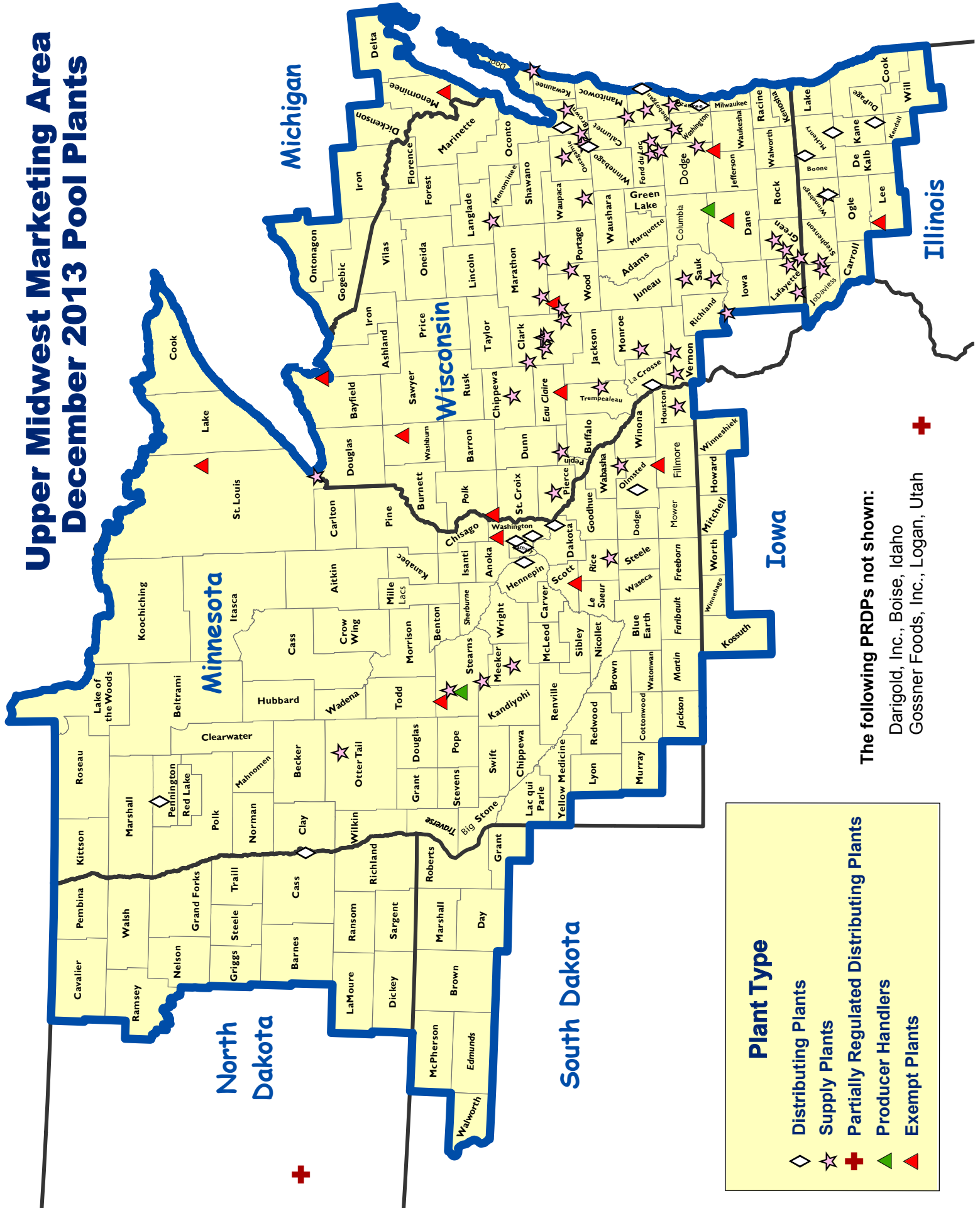

December 2012 Procurement Area

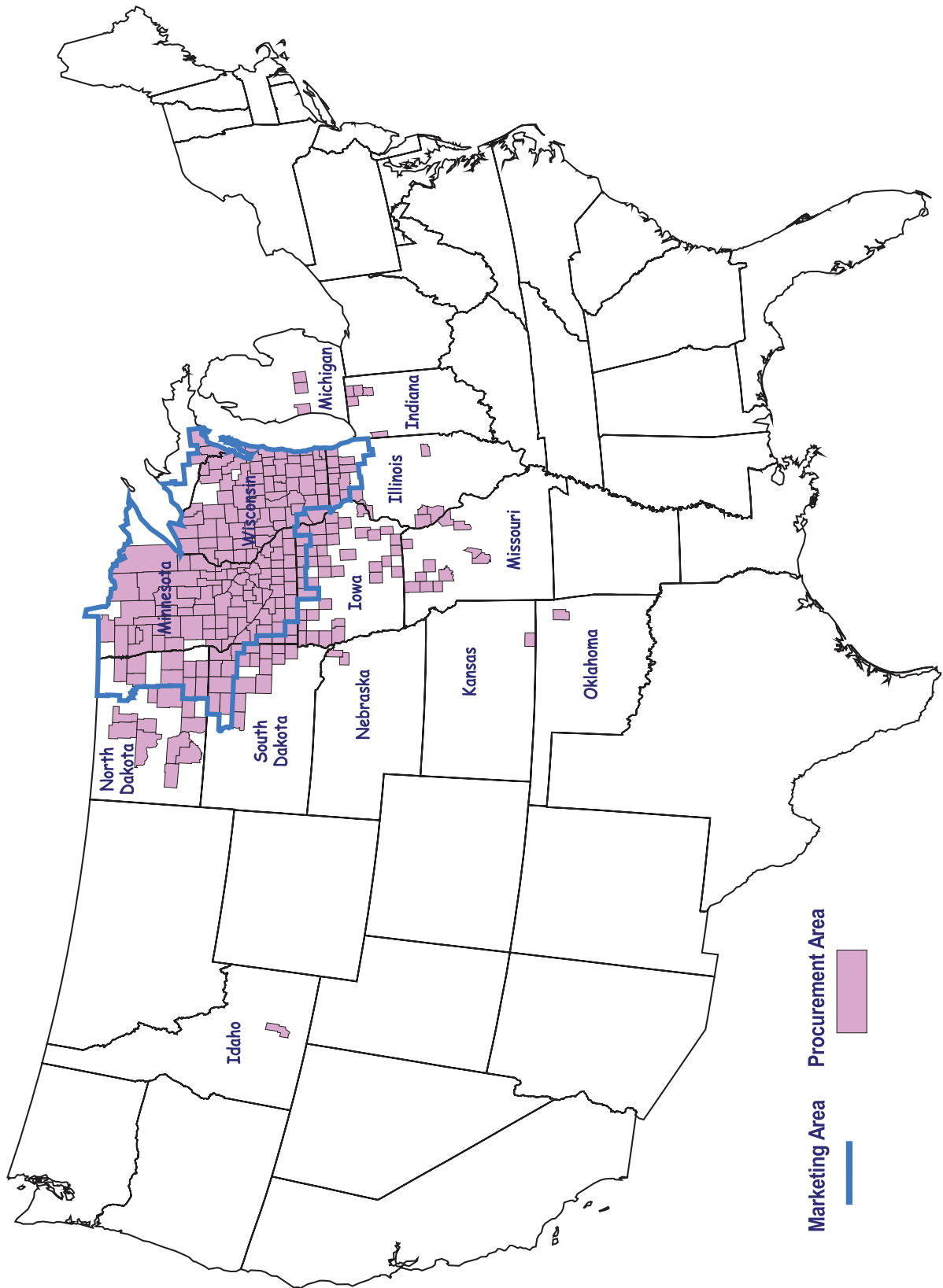

December 2013 Procurement Area

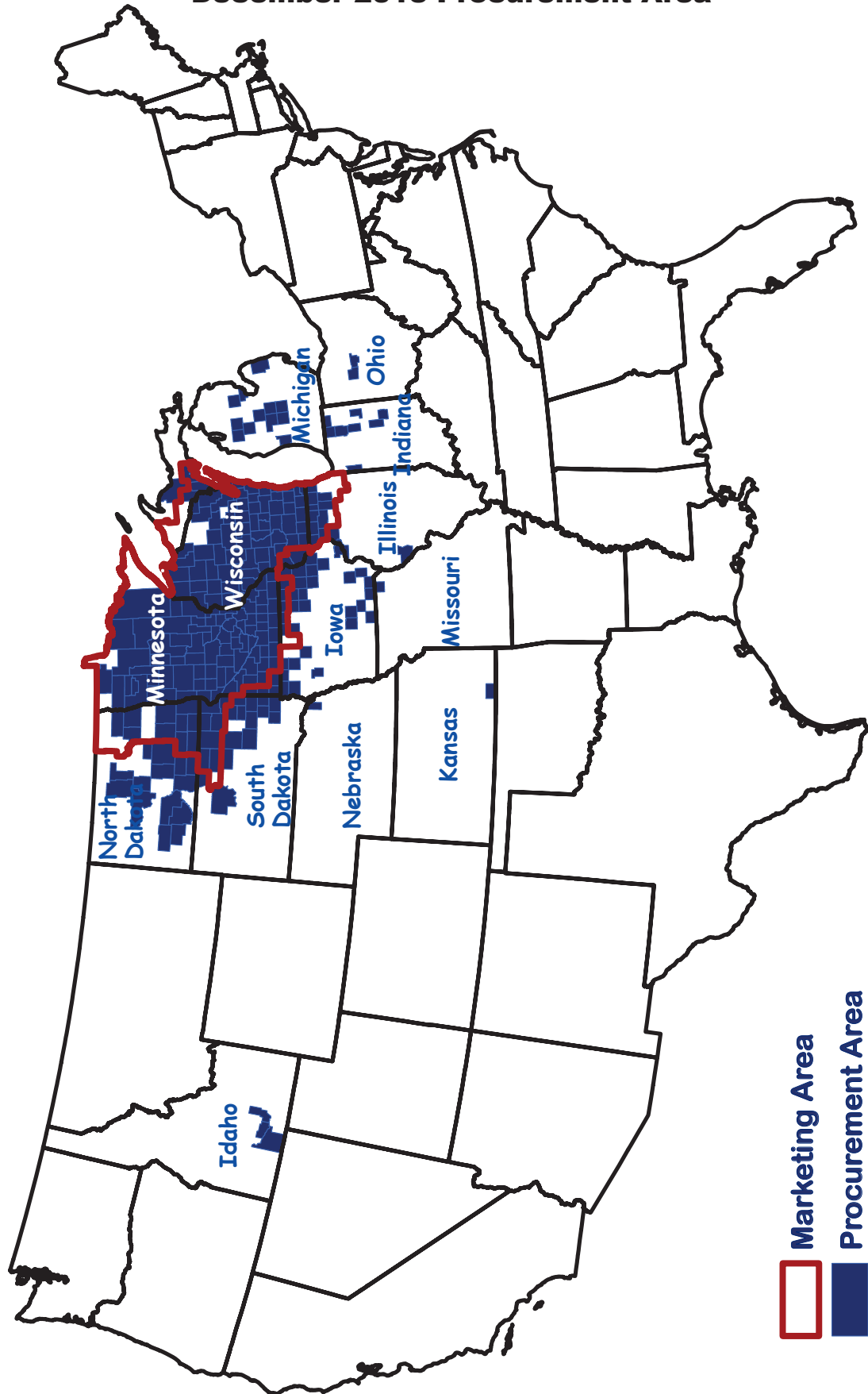
