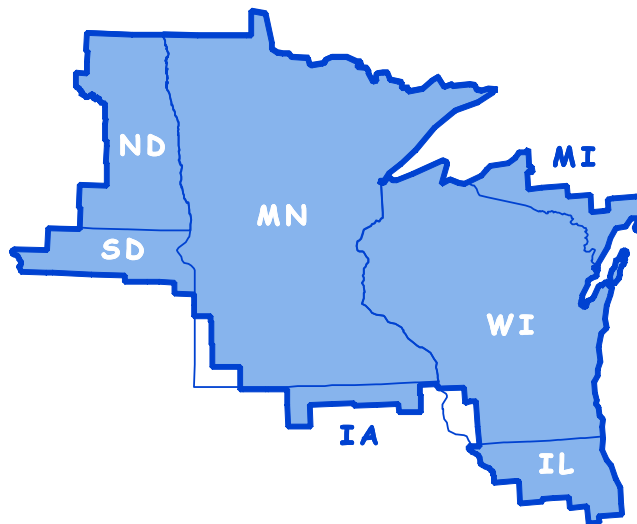

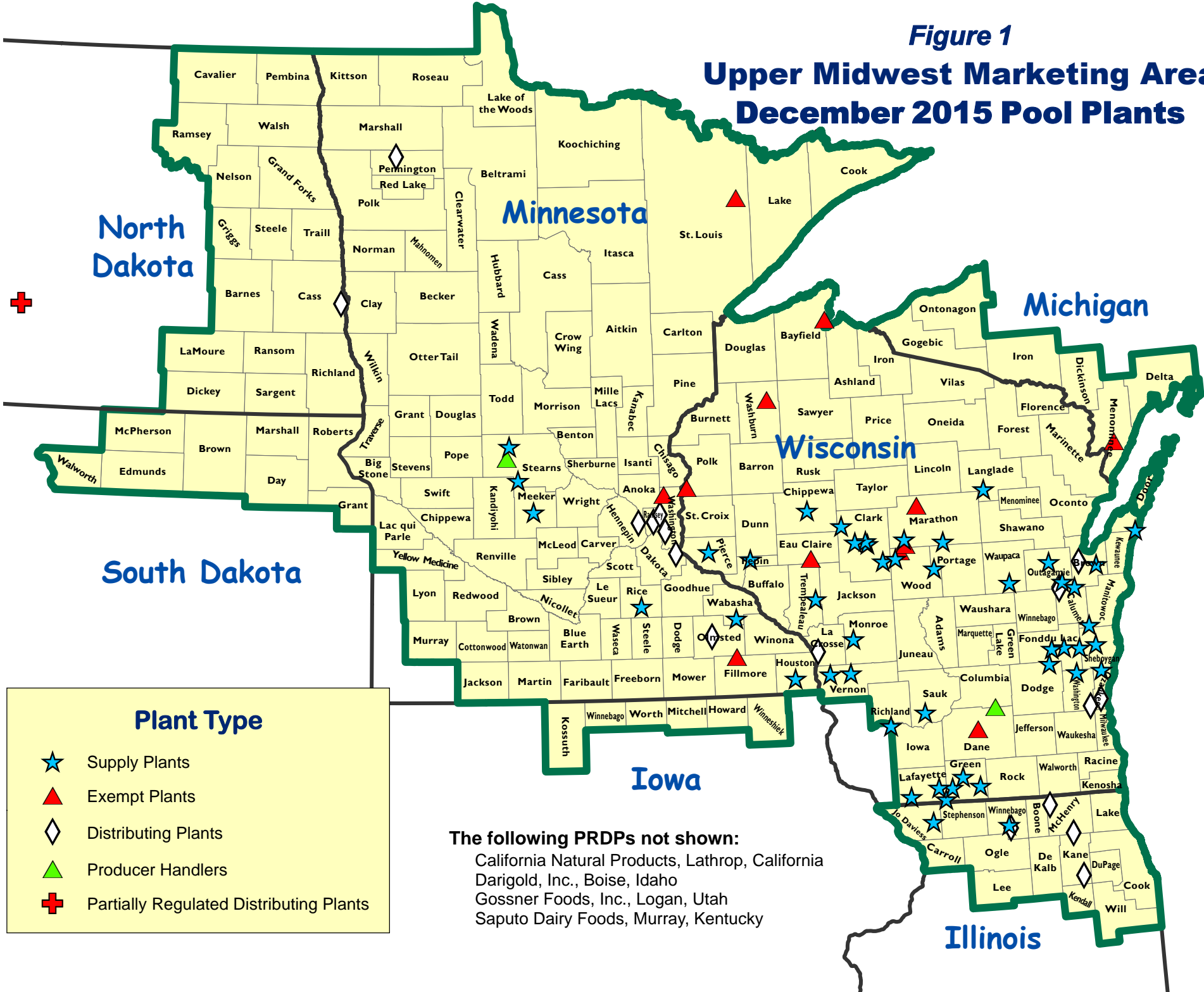

December 2015 Procurement Area

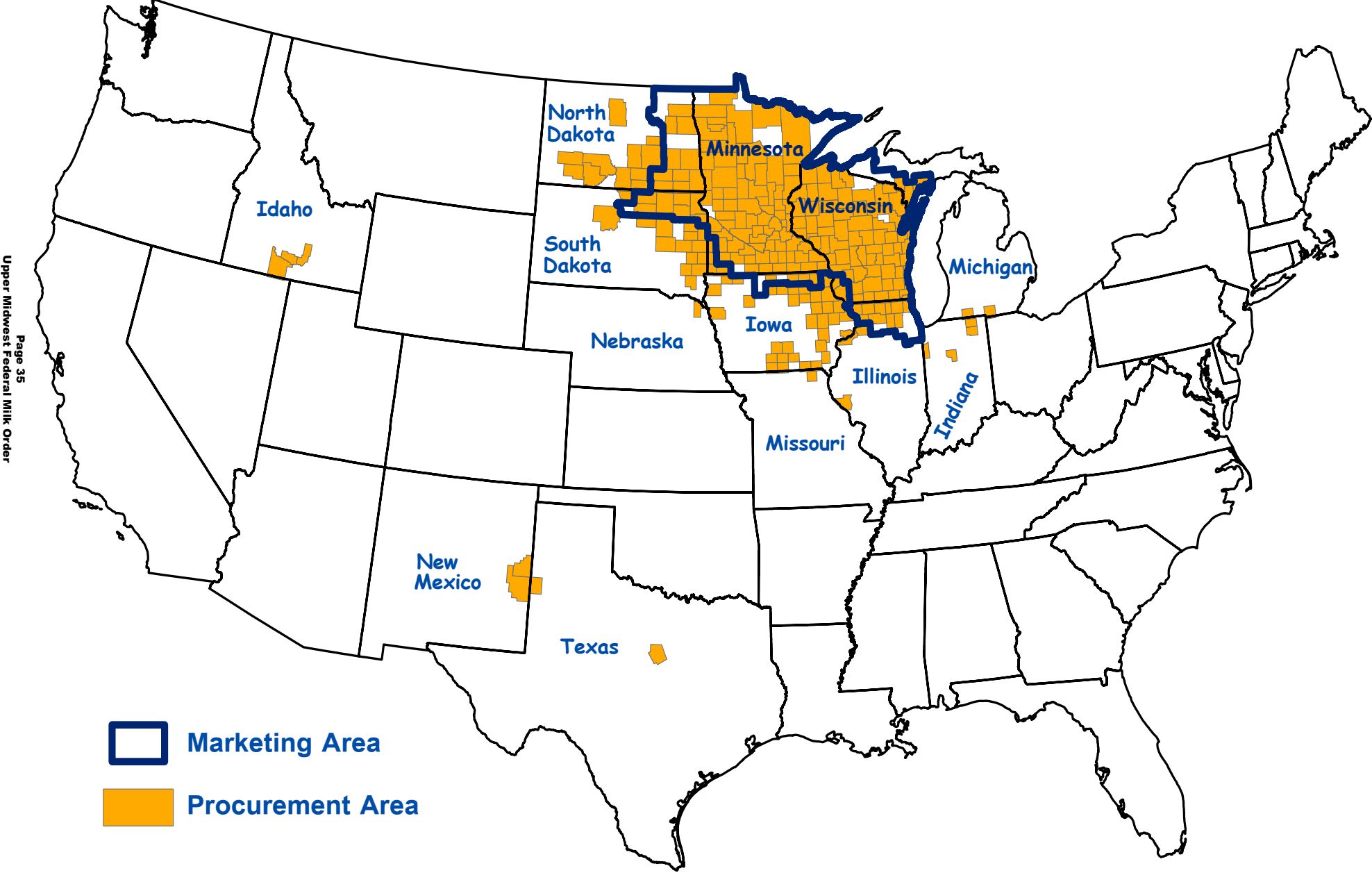
