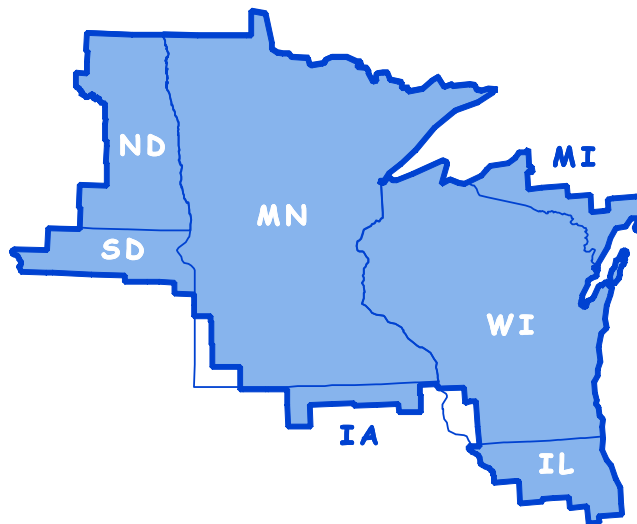

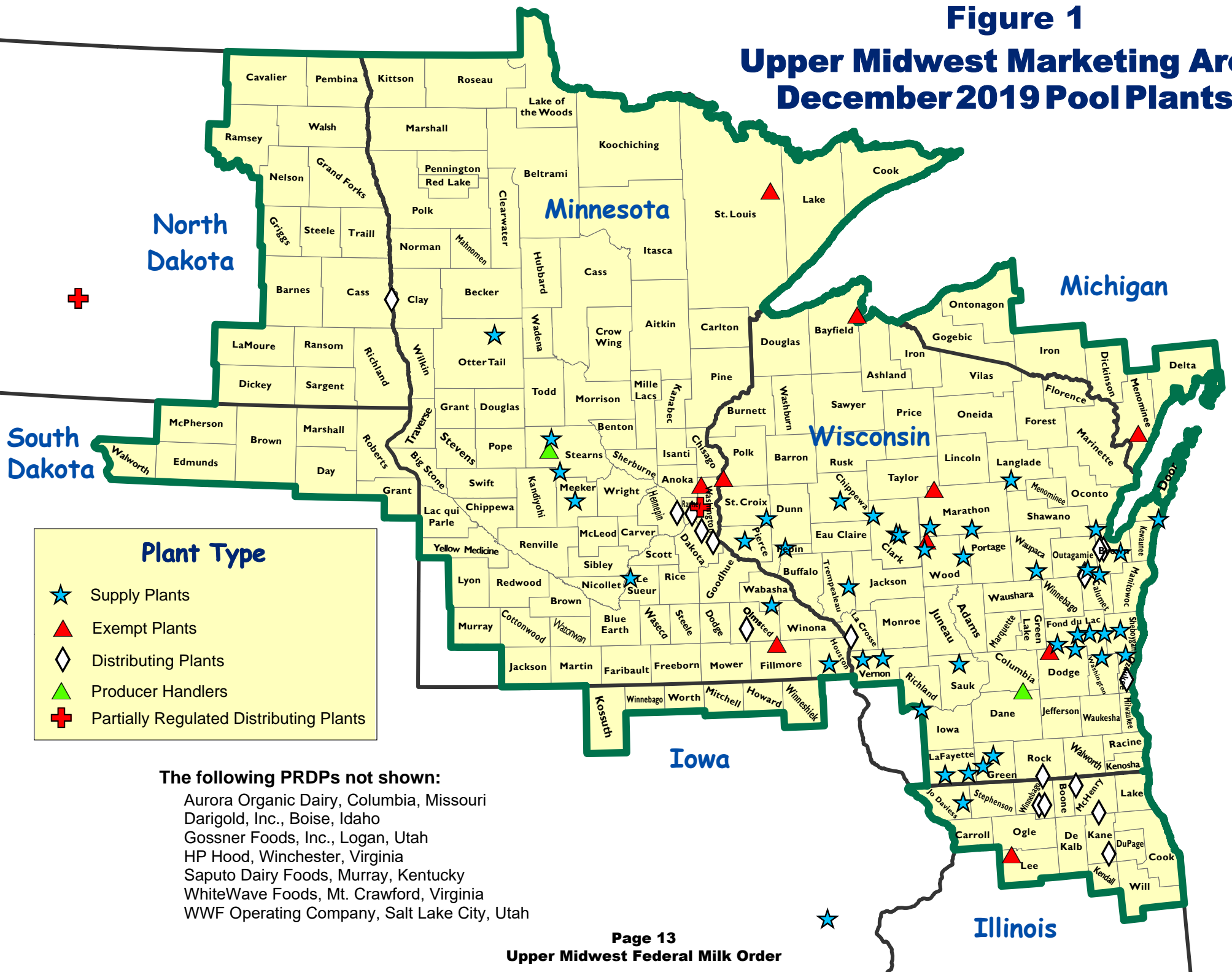

December 2018 Procurement Area**

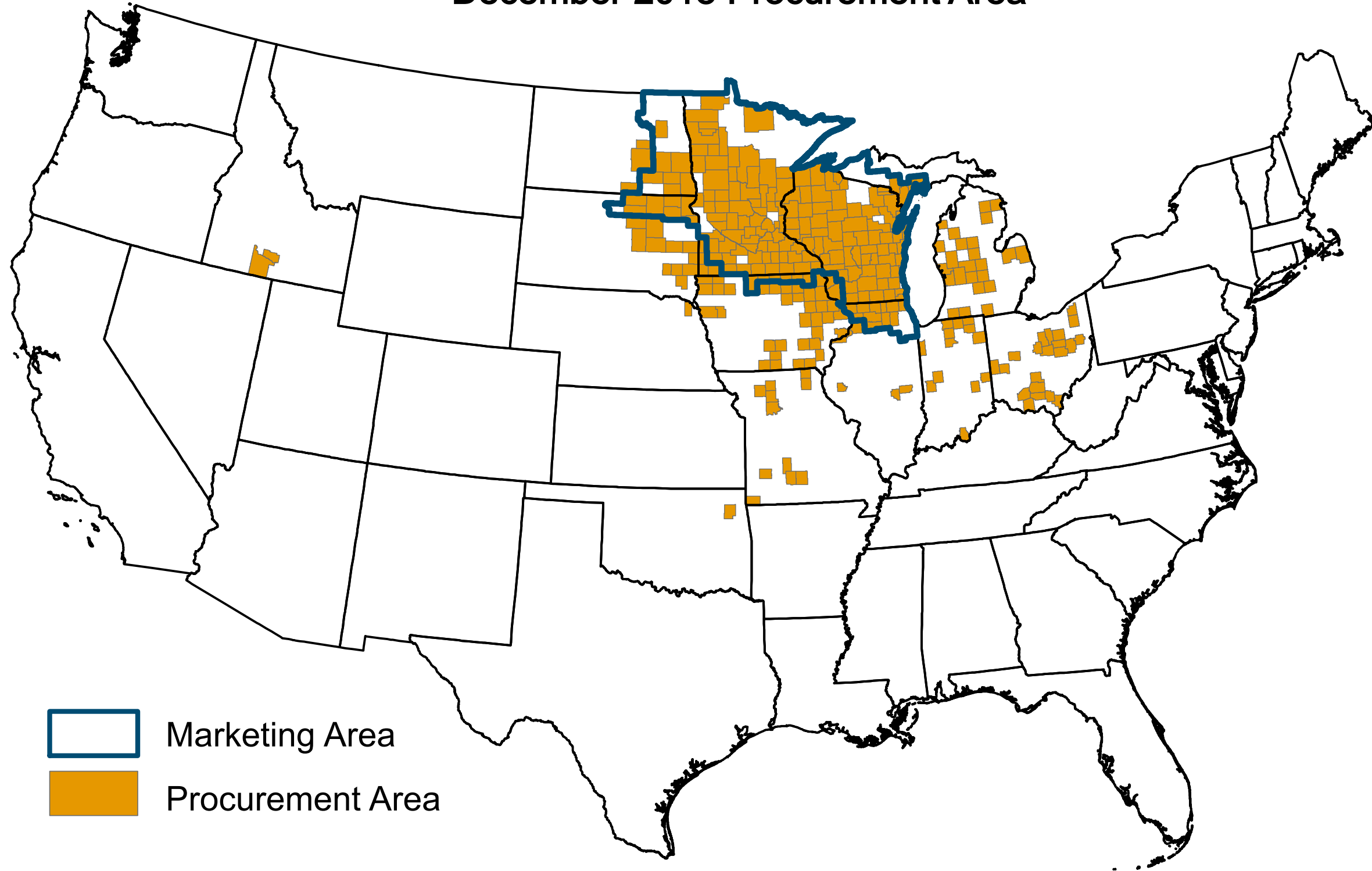

December 2019 Procurement Area**

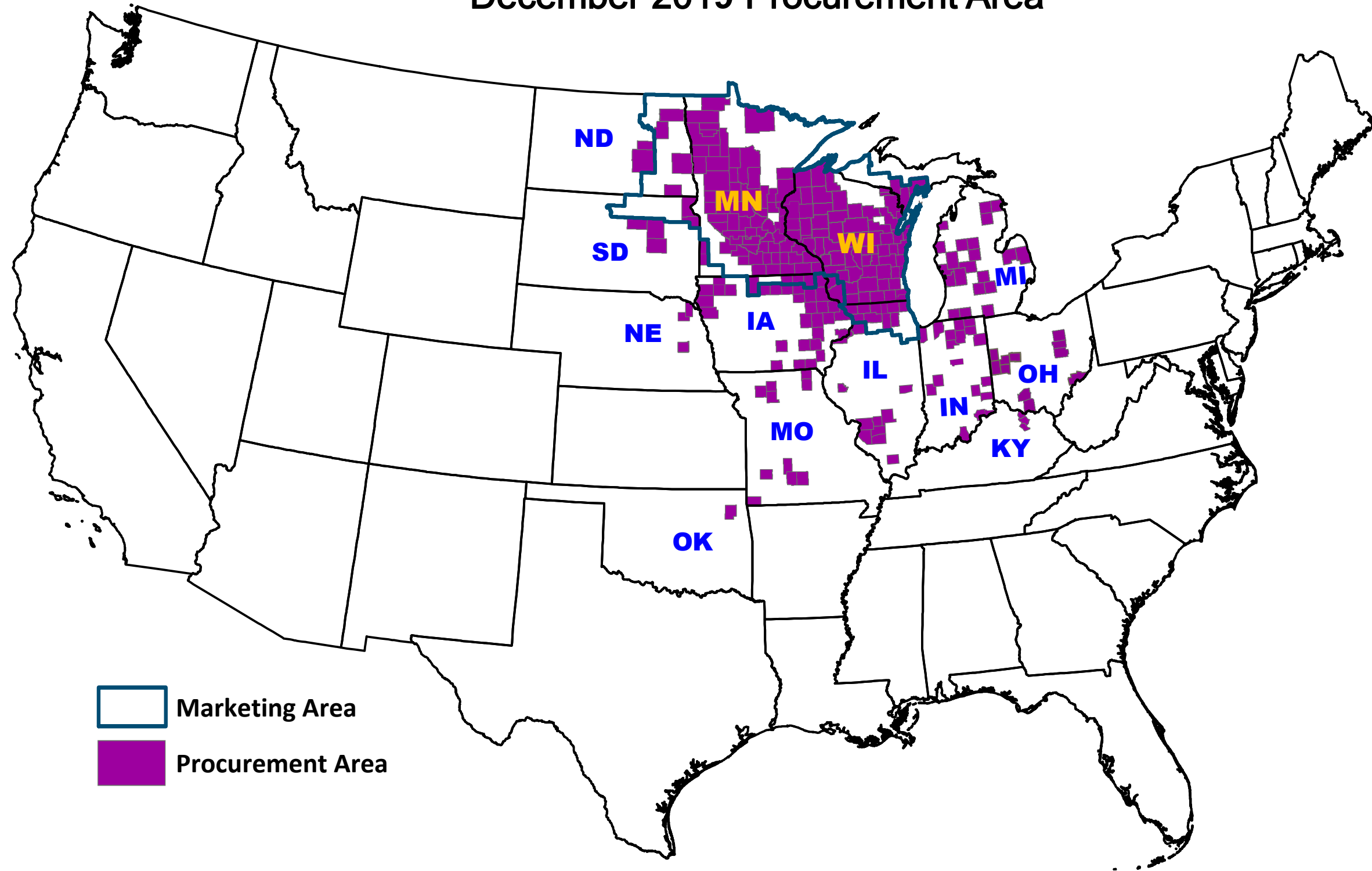
