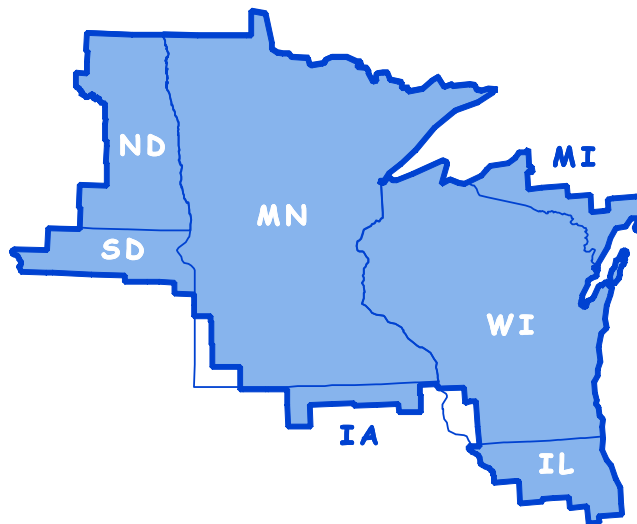

Figure 1: Upper Midwest Marketing Area December 2021 PoolPlants

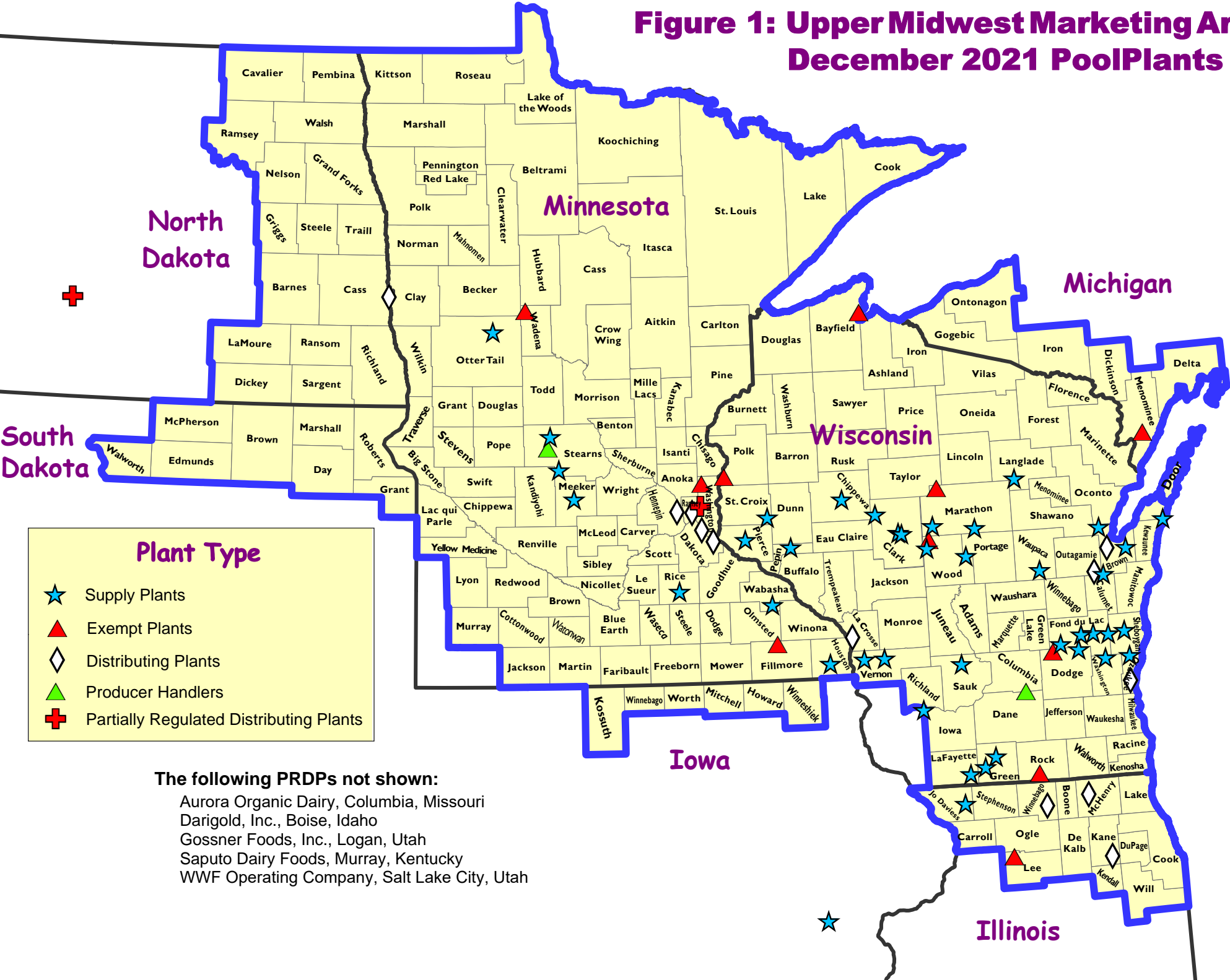

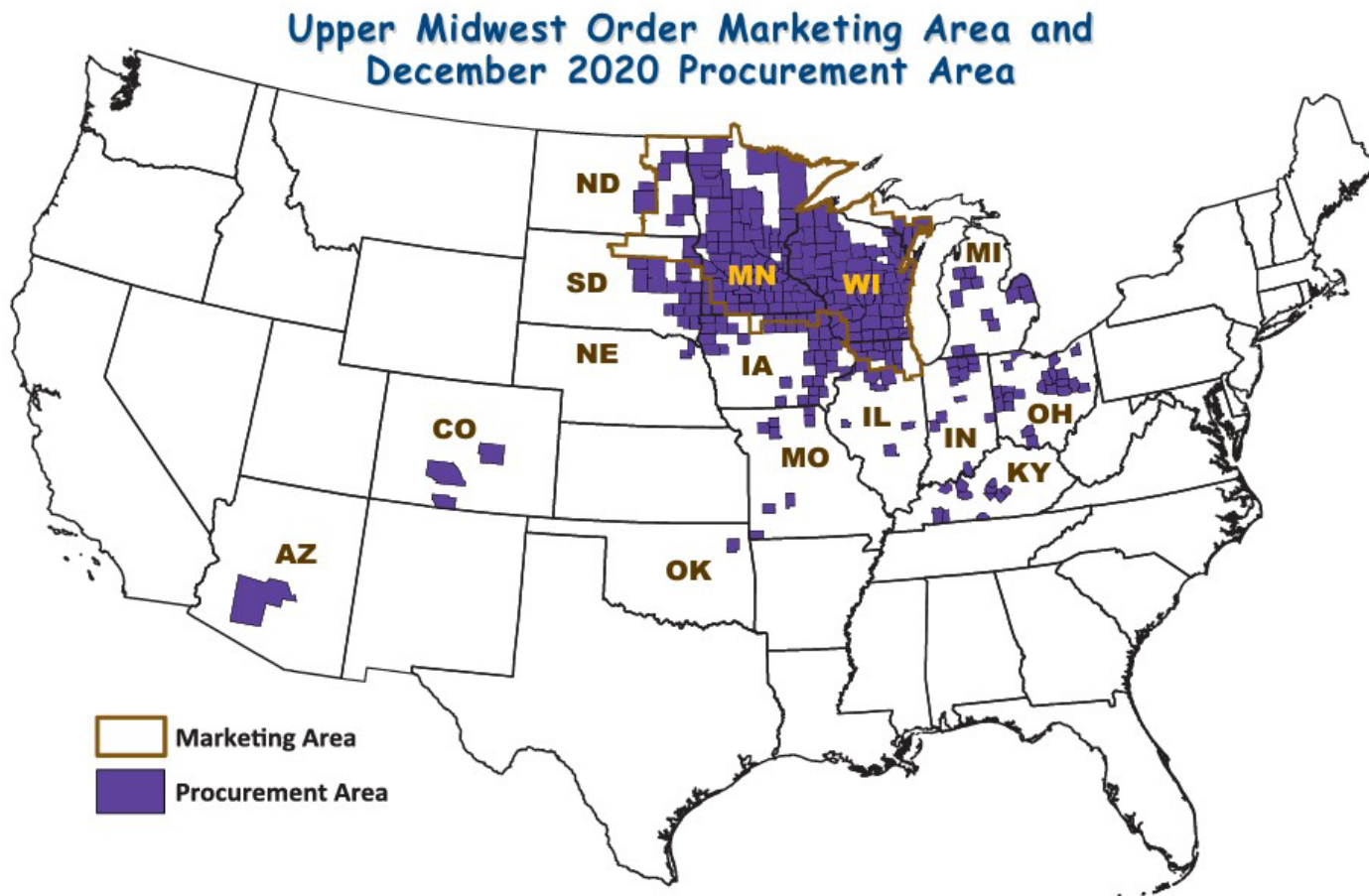

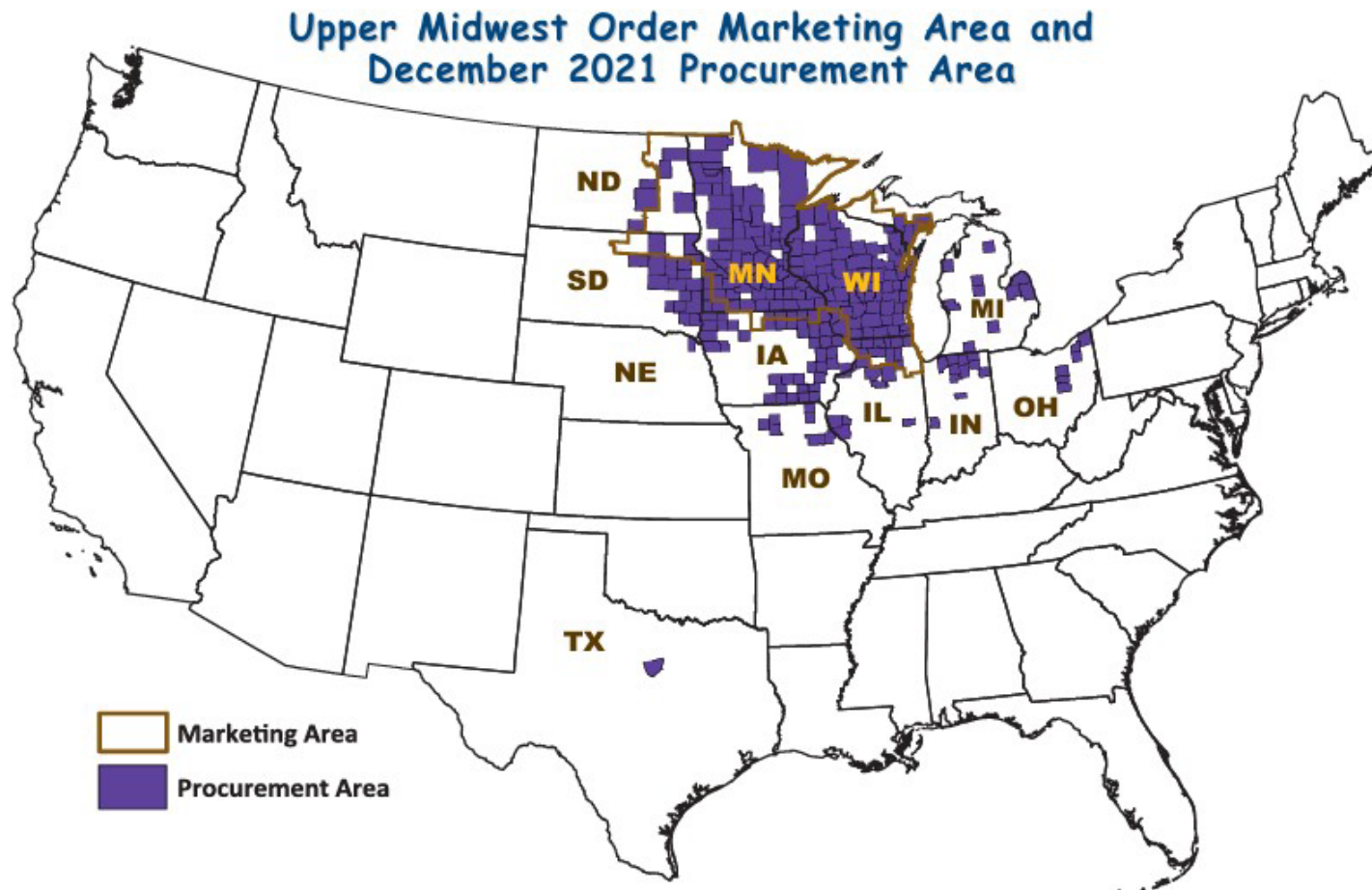
