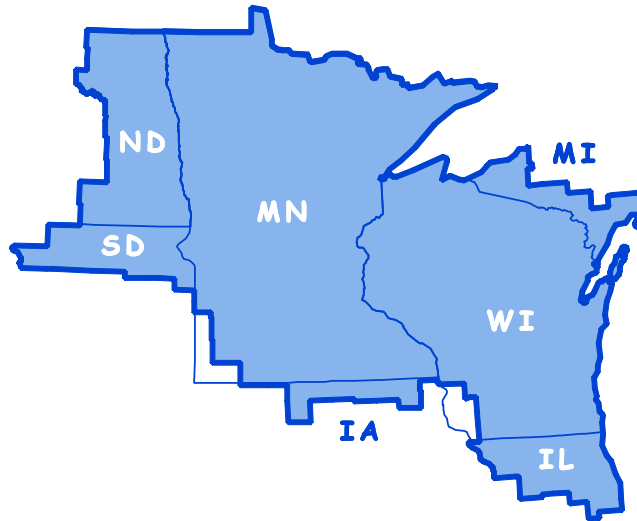

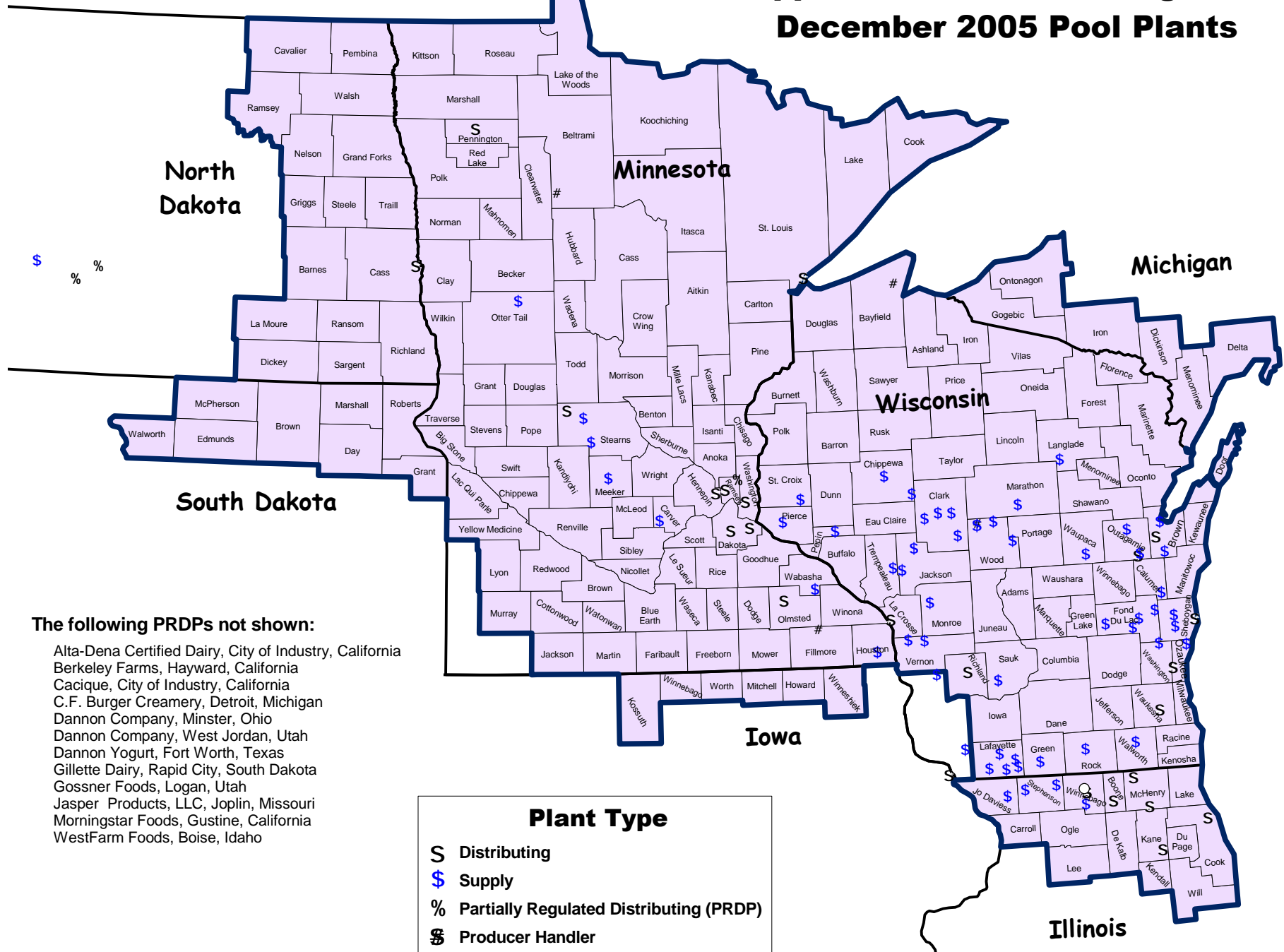

Upper Midwest Marketing Area and December 2004 Procurement Area

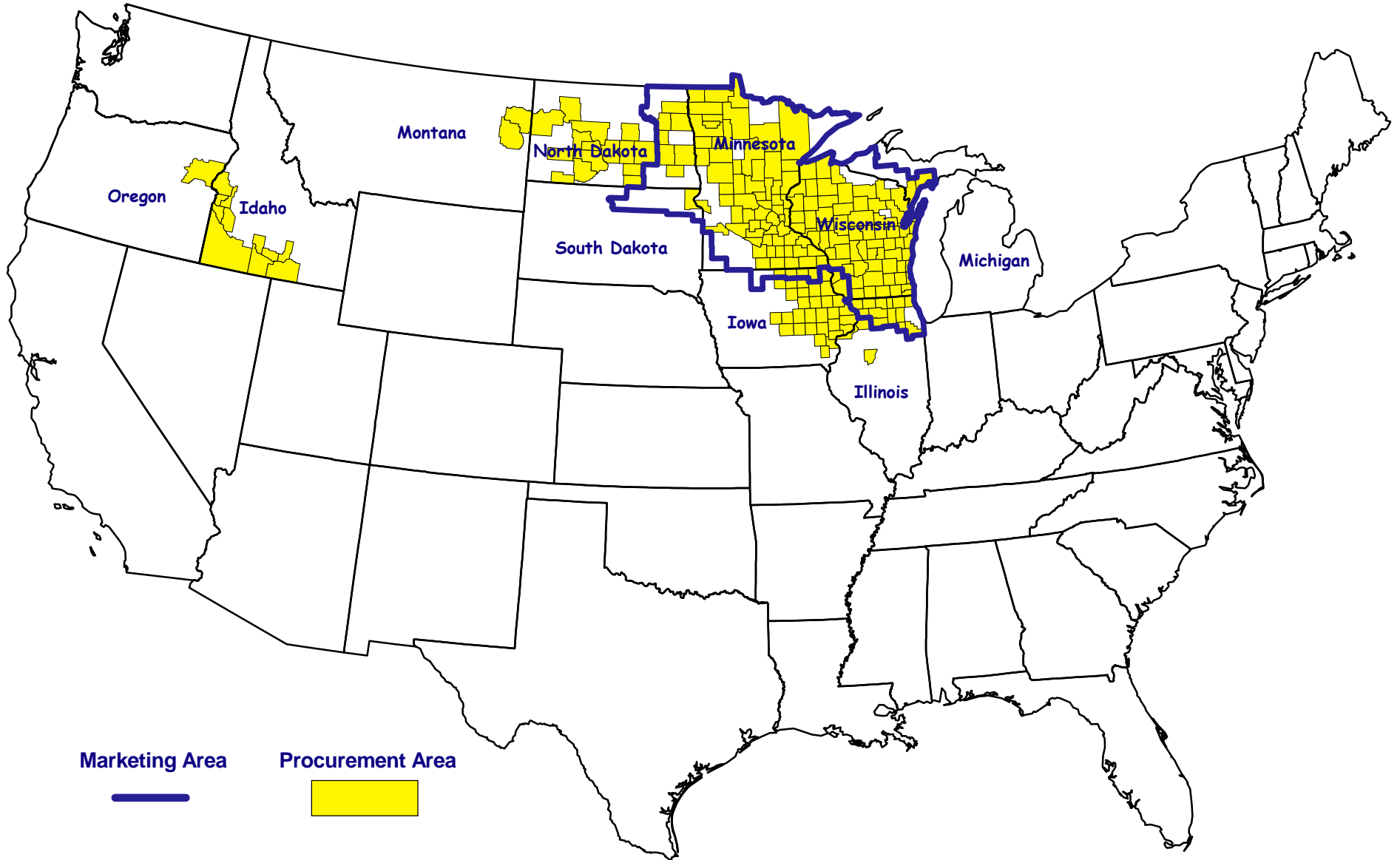

Upper Midwest Marketing Area and December 2005 Procurement Area

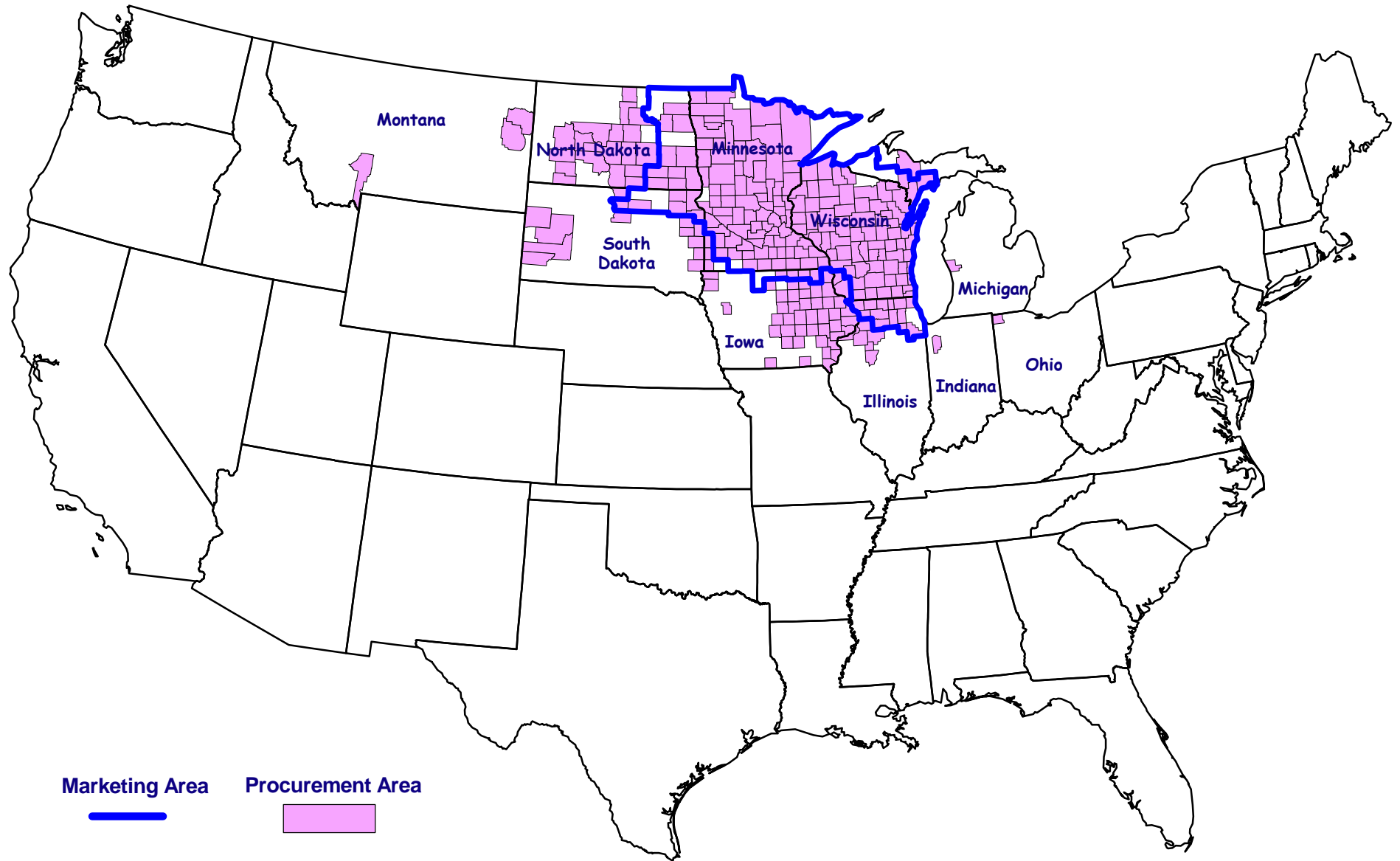
