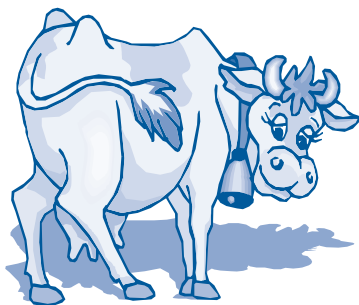

Producer Milk by State and County

During December 2001, producer milk for the Upper Midwest Order was received from 271 counties in 12 states. The table on Pages 2 and 3 shows those producer receipts along with producer milk for December 2000 and the annual change.

During December 2001, 50% of producer milk was received from Wisconsin, with 26% from Minnesota, 12% from California, and nearly 7% from Idaho. The remaining milk, about 5%, was primarily received from Illinois and North and South Dakota. In addition, a small quantity of milk was pooled on the order from each of the states of Iowa, Michigan, Montana, Nebraska, and Utah.

Producer milk in December 2001 totalled 1.83 billion pounds, up nearly 176 million pounds from a year earlier. The increase resulted entirely from the addition of Idaho milk on the order and the increase in California milk, as producer milk from most of the other states declined.

The top five counties from which producer milk was received in December 2001, in declining order of quantity delivered, were: Stearns, Minnesota; Clark, Wisconsin;

Marathon, Wisconsin; Dane, Wisconsin; and Merced, California. Combined receipts from the top five counties accounted for about 16% of total producer milk for the month.

Farm Bill Signed

On May 13, 2002, President Bush signed the Farm Security and Rural Investment Act of 2002 (2002 Farm Bill) into law.

The 2002 Farm Bill requires payments to dairy farmers if the Federal order Class I milk price (i.e., the price of milk for beverage use) is below \$16.94 per cwt. in Boston. The Boston Class I price has been below \$16.94 per cwt. since the benefit period began on December 1, 2001, therefore, dairy farmers will receive payments from that date until the price moves above \$16.94 per cwt.

The rules for implementing this program are currently under development, as are rules for other parts of the 2002 Farm Bill.

Pool Summary

- In April, 13,803 producers delivered to the market with an average daily delivery of 4,389 pounds.
- Producer milk totalled 1.78 billion pounds, up 0.6% on a daily basis from March.
- Class I utilization totalled 344

million pounds, up 2.5% on a daily basis from March.

- Class I usage accounted for 19.3% of producer milk.
- The April Producer Price Differential is \$0.50 per cwt.
- The Statistical Uniform Price is \$11.35 per cwt., up 10¢ from March, but \$1.54 below April 2001.
- Market statistics for April are shown on Pages 4 and 5.

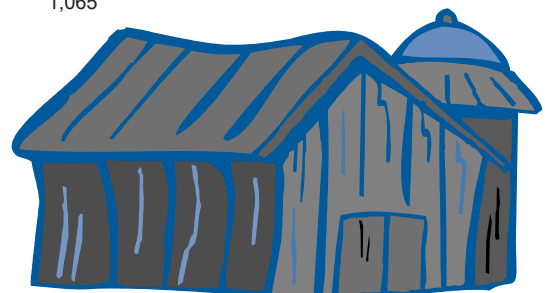

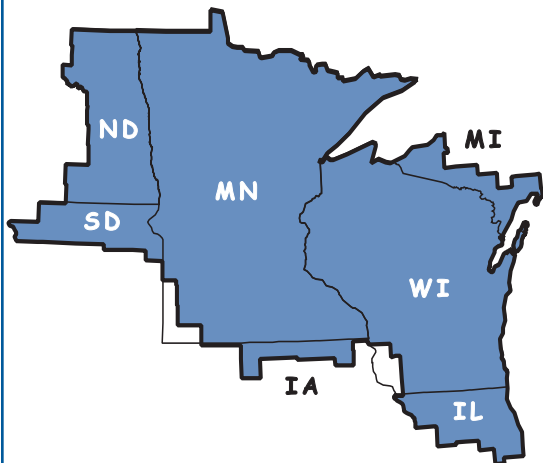
