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

Chicago Mercantile Exchange Prices Up

Prices for cheddar cheese, butter, and nonfat dry milk (NFDM) on the Chicago Mercantile Exchange (CME) increased during late April and most of May, although some settled back slightly later in May. The butter price had the largest increase from month-earlier prices, but 40-pound blocks of cheese had the largest increase from last year.

The CME barrel cheddar cheese price on May 31 was \$1.54½ per pound, up 12¾¢ from the end of April price, but 1½¢ below its peak on May 11. The 40-pound block price of \$1.74½ on May 31 was 26½¢ per pound above the end of April, and at its highest level since early February this year. Barrel and block prices are 12½¢ and 37½¢ above year-earlier levels, respectively.

The CME butter price on May 31 was \$2.41 per pound, jumping 30½¢ from the end of April and 33¾¢ above a year earlier. The peak butter price for the month, and for the year, was \$2.43 on May 16.

The CME NFDM price on May 31 was \$0.95½ per pound, up 8¾¢ from last month and 17½¢ above a year earlier.

The April Federal order Class III price was \$15.22 per cwt., down \$0.59 from March, but \$1.59 above April 2016. The May 31 CME Class III futures price closed at \$15.61 for May, but rises above \$17.00 for July through November, currently peaking at \$17.55 in September, and ending the year at \$16.88.

Upper Midwest Order--Sources of Producer Milk

During December 2016, 81% of producer milk was received from Wisconsin, with 12% from Minnesota (See Table 1 on Page 2). The remaining producer milk, about 7%, was primarily received from Illinois, Iowa, Michigan, North Dakota, and Nebraska. In addition, a small quantity of milk was pooled on the order from each of the states of Arkansas,

Idaho, Indiana, Missouri, New Mexico, Ohio, South Dakota, Texas, and Virginia.

Producer milk in December 2016 totaled 2.1 billion pounds, down 970 million pounds from the previous year, because of a significantly higher volume of eligible milk not pooled because of disadvantages.

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Pool Summary

- In April, producer milk totaled 3.08 billion pounds, up 144 million pounds from March, but 112 million pounds below April 2016.
- Class I utilization totaled 258 million pounds, down 8.9% from March on a daily basis and 9.1% below last year. Class I usage accounted for 8.4% of producer milk. Class I use in April was

a record low for the market, both in pounds and in utilization percentage.

- The April Producer Price Differential (PPD) was \$0.15 per cwt.
- The Statistical Uniform Price was \$15.37 per cwt., down \$0.68 from March, but \$1.59 above April 2016.
- Market statistics for April are shown on Pages 4 and 5.

geous price relationships. Consequently, all the numbers in this article for December 2016 are affected by this large volume of milk not on the order.

The number of counties from which producer milk was received, the number of producers, and pounds of producer milk represented by each state in December 2016 are shown in Table 1 on Page 2. In addition, the percentage of producer milk represented by each state is shown for December of 2016, 2015, and 2014.

The map on Page 2 depicts the states and counties from which producer milk was received in December 2016.

The 15 top counties from which producer milk was received in December 2016 are shown in Table 2, along with the number of producers and pounds of producer milk represented by each county. The rank, number of producers and pounds of producer milk for those same counties for December 2015 are also shown.

All of the top 15 counties in December 2016 were in Wisconsin. The makeup of the top 15 counties in December 2016 was slightly different from a year earlier. The county ranked 4th in 2015, Stearns County, Minnesota, was 16th in 2016. In addition, Winona County, Minnesota was ranked 14th in 2015 and dropped to 25th in 2016, with Stevens County,

Minnesota, ranked 15th in 2015, dropped to 50th in 2016. This resulted in three Wisconsin counties, Chippewa, Sauk and Lafayette, moving into the top 15 in 2016.

There also was significant shifting among the counties that remained in the top 15 in both years, with only 3 remaining in the same position both years.

The top 15 counties supplied 46% of total producer milk on the order in December 2016, and accounted for 38% of the producers. Because of the change in the makeup of the top 15, these same counties in 2015 accounted for only 38% of producer milk and 33% of the producers.
